I hereby agree to the following regulations and conditions while staying at The Inn At The Peak resort with my dog(s):

- I agree to keep my dog on a leash or in a carrier while in public places
- I agree to keep my dog out of all public food areas, including pool and fitness areas.
- I agree that all unattended dogs in sleeping room **MUST** be crated. Plastic is required under crates and will be provided at check in..
- I agree to prevent noise or any other disturbance by my dog, in the interest of other resort guests
- I agree to pay any additional cleaning bills or repairs caused by my stay with my dog(s) should they be required, and authorize the Resort to charge my credit card on file for such charges.
- I agree that my dog weights less than 40 pounds.
- No ex-pens allowed in crating/grooming room or any other indoor area. The Show Committee will govern the use of Private Exercise Pens. Pop-ups **ARE** permitted.
- The event committee reserves the right to remove any areas roped off by exhibitors and to allocate or designate crate and grooming space.
- **Guests are responsible for cleaning up after exercising dogs:** ample waste product bags and receptacles will be provided for your convenience. No soiling indoors.
- Bathing dogs is allowed in designated areas only. **Two bathing stations with tubs will be provided. Towels will be provided but must be left at bathing stations so be sure to bring your own towels along.** Exhibitors are responsible for damages and cleaning up of their grooming activities.
- The TTCA will not be held responsible for anything stolen, lost or damaged either at the show locations or the host resort.

Please remember, the TTCA requires dogs be crated when unattended in the National Specialty hotel rooms and the rooms are to be left in the same condition as when first occupied. Failure to abide by these rules will result in those individual's names being given to future host hotels with the intent of being refused occupancy. As the Host Hotel is also the show grounds, you can be brought up before an AKC Event Committee for not complying with the rule to leave your hotel room in proper condition.

Travel north on I-79 to I-90 East to I-86/Exit 37 and see below.

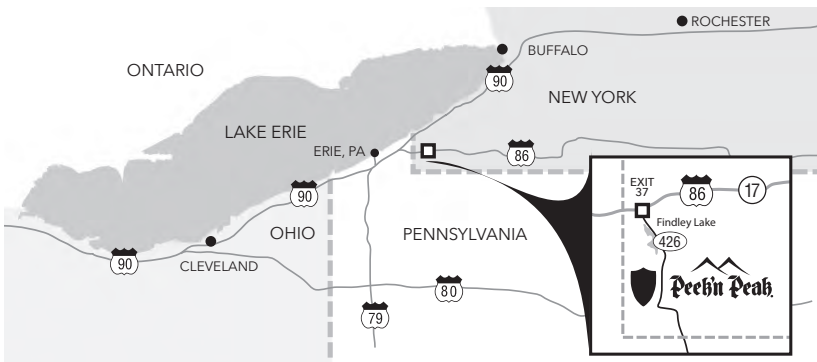

### DEALING WITH LYME DISEASE IN DOGS AND HUMANS

In the Cambridge Room

**Presented by Dr. Cassandra Guarino**

From the Animal Health Diagnostic Center at Cornell University

**And a Representative from FocusOnLyme.org**

To cover the devastating impact of Lyme Disease in humans

Please join us for an educational seminar entitled ***Canine Lyme Disease: Detection, Treatment, and Prevention*** presented by Cassandra Guarino, Ph.D. from the Animal Health Diagnostic Center at Cornell University.

“Lyme disease is caused by the spirochete, *Borrelia burgdorferi*, first identified in human patients in Lyme, Connecticut in 1981. Lyme disease in dogs, aka Canine Borreliosis, was first described in the mid-1980s. As the range of *B. burgdorferi* infected ticks continues to expand, it is essential to know how to protect your dogs by preventing exposure, detecting infection early, and knowing when to pursue treatment.”

Cassandra Guarino received her Ph.D. in Comparative Biomedical Sciences from Cornell University, where she continued as a Postdoctoral Associate with a concentration in vaccine immunology. Dr. Guarino currently serves on the faculty of the Department of Population Medicine and Diagnostic Sciences at Cornell University as an Extension Associate for Serology/Immunology. Dr. Guarino has expertise in the immunological response to infection with *B. burgdorferi*, and she is familiar with the clinical presentations of Lyme disease in both canine and equine patients. In addition, Dr. Guarino is involved with diagnostic assay development and is currently working on the development of an assay that can allow for the early detection of Lyme nephritis, the most devastating form of Lyme disease seen in dogs.

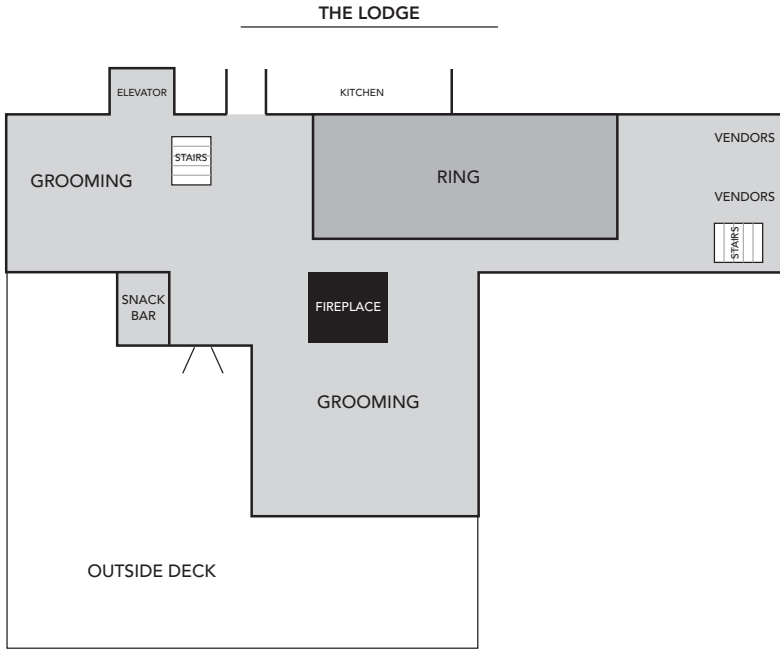
